Behaviour management at Port Curtis Road State School is underpinned by our Levelled Behaviour System.

Students achieving either a Silver or Gold level standard at the end of each term receive a reward for their efforts.

LEVELS:

GOLD level students have demonstrated highly responsible behaviour and participate in both school and community service.

GREEN level students have demonstrated responsible behaviour and generally follow school rules.

AMBER level students have had frequent behaviour reports and remain on this level until improvement is shown.
