Attendance






Porty's Easter Bonnet Parade



A reminder, we are still taking donations for our raffle. Please take these to the office. Student council members are now selling tickets (50c per ticket) each morning before school.





Hi Porty families and welcome to the last PBL newsletter for Term 1. This fortnight we will be focusing on being a good sport.

Teaching kids about being a good sport is an important aspect of their social and emotional development. Here are some tips and strategies to effectively teach this concept:

Lead by example: Children often mimic the behaviour of adults, especially their parents and caregivers. Therefore, it's crucial to model good sportsmanship in your own actions and attitudes, whether you're playing a game with them or observing their activities.

Teach respect: Teach kids to respect their teammates, opponents, coaches, and officials. Emphasize the importance of treating others with kindness, fairness, and empathy both on and off the field.

Discuss fair play: Talk to children about the importance of fair play and following the rules of the game. Help them understand that cheating, arguing, or engaging in unsportsmanlike behaviour not only undermines the integrity of the game but also diminishes their own character.


