- Improve school-wide behaviour data with percentage of students receiving a 'C' or higher in behaviour from 72% to 90%


Our initiatives include

- Providing professional development to build teacher capability in effective pedagogy through visible learning and building student assessment literacy.
- Providing professional development for teaching and non-teaching staff to train in the Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) framework to establish a consistent school-wide approach in managing behaviour.
- Utilising teacher-aides to assist in student engagement and inclusion.
- Providing early oral language intervention for students in the early years.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Prioritising oral language development in the early years through an oral language program and individualised speech programs.
- Using co-constructed learning walls to build student assessment literacy.
- Engaging in small school cluster moderation to build teacher capability in 'before' moderation process and learning walk and talks.
- Employing additional teacher aides to support student engagement and differentiated learning.
